How do you know if it's suspicious? Look for ACUTE signs of danger!

ACCURATE

Does the grammar or information look off?

Does it make you think, "Hmm I want to know more?" Scams are designed to pique curiosity with things like "special" announcements or offers.

UNEXPECTED

Did it come to you out of the blue? Were you expecting this message?

TIME

Does the message press urgency? Did it say something like "You have 24 hours to respond" or "URGENT"?

EMOTION

Did the message invoke some form of emotion in you? Fear of missing out on a deal? Some form of guilt or shame?

If a message triggers any of these warning signals, delete it and block the sender!
